Nizwa, Jebel Shams-Grand Canyon

Enjoy a great day out driving through the fascinating Hajar Mountains. Visit Nizwa, the ancient capital of Oman with its fascinating Souq and Nizwa Fort, built in the 17th century which provides stunning views from its tower. Your tour continues to Al Hamra, one of the last loam villages in Oman and you head up to Jebel Shams, 'Sun Mountain' -Oman's highest peak nearly 3000 meters. At the mountain's upper reaches is the 'Grand Canyon', which gives breathtaking views down to its floor.
